Activities

Our Rhoer Club participates in many social, educational and civic activities. Annual activities include regional and national conventions, volunteering in our Buckle Up America initiative, as well as participating in our Youth Symposium, and many other local programs designed to build the self esteem of each girl and the sisterly bonds of the entire club. Other events such as overnight retreats, field trips, and seminars promote positive interactions and fun, educational experiences for each member. The Rhoer Club also participates in a number of fundraisers to defray costs such as conference and activity fees that are not fully covered by dues. The Rhoer experience culminates in the opportunity to apply for academic scholarships upon entering college. All of these activities, only done by permission of the parent, are structured to enhance each girl's experience and hopefully prepare her for the road to womanhood.
